

# Breeze Hill Neighbourhood Health Centre

Breeze Hill Neighbourhood Health Centre houses Walton Medical Centre, Grey Road Medical Centre, Primary Care Trust Community Services and a Lloyds Pharmacy.

The eye catching building is situated in a prime location at the junction of Liverpool's ring road and the busy route of Rice Lane.

The building has been designed to respond to the demands of the site, which is dominated by the proximity of a large concrete flyover. Thus, the building provides a new frontage to both Queens Drive and Rice Lane.

Construction on the project commenced in September 2006 and the building was officially handed over to the Liverpool PCT on February 1st 2008.

As well as the two GP surgeries, a wide range of community primary care services are provided from the building. This allows the centre to provide both diagnostic and treatment services in the same place, which offers the public a single point of service that was previously not provided.
