## Transforming Community Services

The £11.5m Adelaide Health Centre created the opportunity for the community to receive a range of services in one convenient location. The services Adelaide Health Centre provide improve healthcare to the Millbrook community and Southampton as a whole. The services are offered in a modern, state of the art building that has been built in cooperation with local residents and colleagues from NHS Southampton. The Adelaide Health Centre benefits the local community by providing a wide variety of primary and community care services, as well as a GP led health centre, open 8am—8pm, 365 days a year.



## A Centre for the Whole Community

The modern accommodation is arranged around a central atrium, which houses a café in the waiting area that can be used by patients and local residents. Designed to be in keeping with its surroundings, the building's opening at the back leads onto a wildlife garden providing a therapeutic environment. The centre was built in cooperation with the local residents to improve local ownership of the building and create an environment for the patients and residents to enjoy.



## Partnership Working

The Adelaide Health Centre was built under the Government's Local Improvement Finance Trust (LIFT) scheme. The building clearly demonstrates LIFT's capacity and procurement route. The building opened in October 2009 and has a pharmacy that will compliment the GP surgery.
